# PASSETTO

Passetto is an area of Ancona where there is an unusual war memorial. It's near the sea and if you climb to the top of the monument you can enjoy a stunning view of the Adriatic sea. Next to the monument there are two staircases that take you directly to the rocky beach

## How to get to Passetto

- Bus line 1/3, 1/4, CD, 91, 92,
- On foot, from Cavour Square to Passetto you can have a beautiful walk down Viale della Vittoria
- By car, but there is a very small car park for which you have to pay

# CARDETO PARK

High up above the sea there is Cardeto Park, a large area of about 35 hectares close to the centre of the city. It is the largest urban park in Ancona and a very precious green reserve. On the top of the hill there is both the old and the new lighthouse and from there you can see a fantastic view of Passetto seaside.

# PLEBISCITO SQUARE

Plebiscito Square, also called Pope square, is located in the very city-centre. It was built during the XV century and some people say that it's one of the best squares in Ancona, but it's also the oldest. The shape of the square is rectangular and at the bottom there is the statue of Clemente XII, the Pope to whom the square is dedicated. In the Square there are many bars and pubs and even a museum. It's one the favourite meeting point for the youth especially at night.

# SAINT CIRIACO'S CATHEDRAL

The Cathedral of Ancona is dedicated to Saint Ciriaco and is the cathedral of the Archdiocese of Ancona-Osimo. It's one of the most interesting churches in Italy, fusion of Roman style and Byzantine decorations. It's set in a scenic position at the top of Guasco Hill and from here people can see the whole city of Ancona and its gulf.



# How to get to San Ciriaco's Cathedral

- On foot

# ARCH OF TRAJAN

The Arch of Trajan is the most important monument of the Roman period and also the symbol of the town. It is a Roman Triumphal arch erected by the Senate and people of Rome in the reign of Emperor Trajan to thank him who had expanded the port.



## How to get to Arch of Trajan

- You can get there only on foot because there are no buses and you are not allowed to get in by car because it is in the port.

# LAZZARETTO

- ▶ The Lazzaretto of Ancona is an 18th-century building constructed on an artificial island for the purpose of serving as quarantine station and Leprosarium for the port town of Ancona. It's also called Mole Vanvitelliana because it was built by Luigi Vanvitelli, the engineer and architect who has built the Reggia di Caserta too.

You can go hiking in the mountain and at the top of it enjoy the wonderful view




You can visit Saint Maria's Church, a small masterpiece of Roman art, built by Benedictine monks after 1034


# Sui Club
